Incident	would like to request for redress for the result of the first race. When we arrived at the finish line, the race committee was very near the finish mark, pushed down by the IND 59, making it impossible for us to cross the line. We rounded the finish mark to the starboard, dropped the spinnaker went back to the race committee and waited for the finish line to be placed, but it was still impossible to cross the line because of the anchor line. Then we decided to leave the finish area, because the 2nd race was starting soon. We finished the race and rounded the finish mark before the ISR 5.

Procedural matters	
Facts found	1) On March 30th at 16:40 the Race Committee posted a notice explaining how to use the online system; POL 7 did not read that notice. 2) POL 7 filed a generic request at 14:59 addressing the race committee. 3) The protest time limit was 15:15. 4) The alleged incident happened at 12:04. 5) At 15:23 the race committee replied inviting the competitor to lodge a hearing request. 6) At 15:34 POL 7 filed a hearing request.
Conclusion	1) POL 7 failed to deliver the request for redress within the protest time limit or two hours after the incident, as required by RRS 61.2(b)(1). 2) There was no good reason for the PC to extend the time.
