Incident	I was on the leeward of FRA-307 and AUS-4444. Then AUS broken the rule 19 against FRA, after that FRA lost the control and he crash me with the sail on my head

Procedural matters	1. The panel of the international jury was composed in accordance with RRS N1.4(b). 2. ISR 68 was represented by Lidor Toledo. 3. AUS 4444 was represented by Philip Cripsey. 4. Stav Beimel (coach of ISR 68) attended the hearing as an interpreter for ISR 68 5. Jose Moreno (coach of ISR 68) and Mitchell Pearson (coach of AUS 4444) attended the hearing as observers.
Facts found	Protest: 1. At the time of the incident ISR 68 did not hail "protest" at any time to AUS 4444. After the incident the boards were at a distance of approximately 50 metres. 2. The incident occurred during race 14. The iQFOiL Men's Silver fleet completed 2 more races on that day. 3. ISR 68 stated that he saw AUS 4444 in the succeeding starts, but did not inform him about his intention to protest. 4. There was no serious damage or injury that was obvious to ISR 68 at the time of the incident. 5. Upon arriving ashore, ISR 68 identified the protestee by watching a video. Subsequently, he submitted a protest and a request for redress. 6. ISR 68 was not able to find AUS 4444, who has left the venue. 7. ISR 68 and AUS 4444 met outside the hearing room where they were waiting for at least 2 hours. 8. ISR 68 did not inform AUS 4444 about his intention to protest. Request for redress: 1. The written form did not state any reason for making the request for redress.



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Conclusion	Protest: 1. ISR 68 failed to inform AUS 4444 of their intention to protest at the first reasonable opportunity as required by RRS 60.2(b). Request for redress: 1. The request for redress does not identify the reasons for making it, as required by RRS 61.2.
