Incident	I would like to request redress for Race 18 of the championship, the second race of the day. Today, we were competing in the upwind sprint format, and I was in heat 2. After the start of Race 18, the wind was extremely light, barely enough for foiling, and several boards stopped foiling near Mark 1. Midway through the race, we heard a race abandoned signal, and suddenly, all the coach boats and one red jury boat entered the racing area, creating massive confusion as no one knew exactly what was happening. In the end, the Race Committee was only abandoning heat 3, but the situation caused significant disruption to our race, with coach boats and a jury boat interfering in the course. The race turned into complete chaos. Not only was the wind absurdly light for an upwind sprint, but the presence of many boats in the middle of the course made it impossible to cross the finish line.
