Incident	I request a redress based on an improper action by the protest cometee in giving redress for GBR 221586 in race 9 and 10. The decision of protest comete in protest hearing numer 105 have significantly worsened my score in the series as I was excluded from the medal race. I believe incident involving GBR did not cause damage to her boat nor injury to her body.

Procedural matters	
Facts found	1. The panel of the International Jury reviewed the decision of Case 105. 2. POL 217121 claimed that her score in the series was made significantly worse by the decision taken in Case 105, as in the result, POL 217121 did not qualify for the medal race. 3. POL 217121 stated that the videos she presented during the hearing showed that there was possibly no incident between GBR 221586 and BER 225787. 4. POL 217121 believed that GBR 221586's injury would not prevent her from sailing during races 9 and 10.
Conclusion	1. The conclusion and decisions of Case 105 are supported by the facts founds. 2. The International Jury is convinced that GBR 221586 sustained injury to her knee during the incident with BER 225787, which made her score in races 9 and 10 significantly worse through no fault of her own. Therefore, the requirements for redress under RRS 61.4(b)(2) in case 105 were met. (See decision Case 105). 3. The redress given in the decision of Case 105 was the fairest possible arrangement for all boats affected in accordance with RRS 61.4(c), and was made in accordance with the World Sailing Policies, including WS Case 116. 4. Hence, there was neither an improper action nor improper omission of the International Jury. The requirements for redress in RRS 61.4(b)(1) are not met.
